The ACBC meetings are held the Thursday preceding the 3rd Saturday of each Month at 7:00 pm.

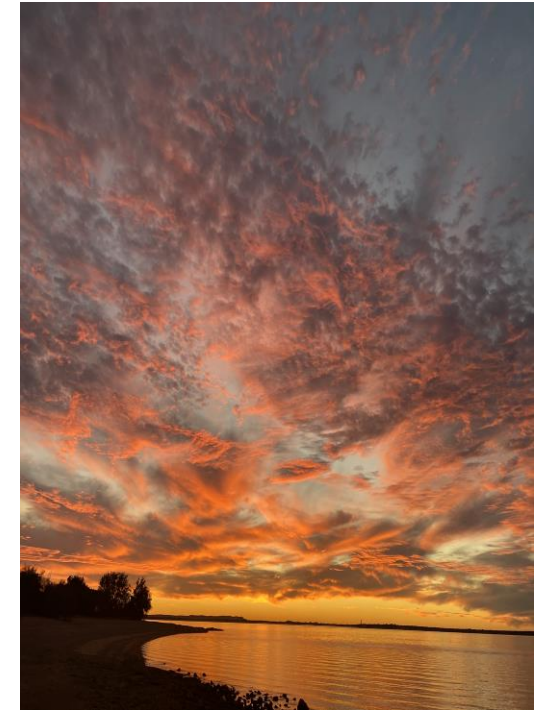

Membership

Membership shall be open to any man who is an active member of any Christian church in the Austin area and who is at least eighteen years old. Fifteen- to eighteen-year-old males may become ACBC members under the following provisions. The candidate for membership must be related to a member and must come with a favorable recommendation from two members other than the related member. A new member in this category will fish his first tournament with the relative or one of the sponsors and must bear his fair portion of all tournament expenses.

If you have a boat, you are classified as a rigger and will be partnered with a non-rigger. If you do not have a boat, you will be partnered with someone who has one. Each tournament is a draw so no two partners will be selected repeatedly. This gives everyone a chance to make new friends and learn different techniques and fishing equipment

We fish local Central Texas lakes including Lake Austin, Belton, LBJ, Travis, Fayette, Buchanan, Stillhouse and more.

Once a year we will have a two-day travel tournament which has included Choke, Fork and more. Lakes are voted in by members attending club meetings each month to fish the best lakes in the area. We give awards for each tournament and year-end awards as well.

Tournament fees are \$20/per boat for regular club tournaments and \$15 for couple's club tournaments. No tournament fee for Retiree tournament.

Dues are as follows: \$7 per year for couple's club, \$24 per year for regular club and \$12 a year for Retiree club. You may fish as a visitor for two tournaments free of charge in any tournament you choose.

ACBC Community Outreach

In addition to our own fishing tournaments, members participate in several community outreach programs.

We host *Hero's Night Out* by taking disabled veterans fishing for the day and ending with a family picnic and awards. *Casts for Kids* is a program where special needs children can spend the day on the lake fishing. ACBC also hosts the *amputee tournament* and other charity events as well.
